TWIN DAY

Although you are being given a certain amount of freedom in dress for “Twin Day,” it is important that you understand that the following rules must be followed:

1. Clothing should not be form fitting, revealing or ripped.

Although you are being given a certain amount of freedom in dress for "Era Day," it is important that you understand that the following rules must be followed:

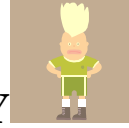
